#### **Most recent updates**

Due to the governors most recent order that takes effect on May 29<sup>th</sup>, we are asking our customers to begin wearing masks as soon as possible. Please respect this order and help us to make customers and employees safe.

In an effort to help you and the community, masks are available for sale in the golf shop. We will make a donation to the Feeding Southwest Virginia Food-bank for each mask purchased.

Our restaurant is now open for Patio dining as well as takeout or delivery. Please consider joining us for a meal before or after your round.

#### **Current Safety practice**

- 1) Only 1 rider per cart (unless you are immediate family or living together)
- 2) Golf carts are being thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before and after the round
- 3) We will be allowing walking at any time during this crisis
- 4) PVC Pipes placed in the cups, making it easier to remove your ball without touching surfaces
- 5) All rakes, ball washers, and sand bottles have been removed from the course
- 6) High contact areas; counters, key pads, credit card terminals, door knobs and railings are being cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis

#### **Things we are asking of our customers**

- 1) Per Governor Northams executive order, please wear a mask while inside
- 2) If you are feeling ill, or displaying any flu like symptoms, please stay home
- 3) Do not touch the flagstick, (Gimmies are encouraged)
- 4) Dispose of your own trash from the carts and return them to the staging area
- 5) Wash your hands frequently
- 6) Respect the CDC guidelines for social distancing. Do not gather as a group
- 7) If you would prefer, you may call the golf shop (540)344-7848 to pay for your round or merchandise over the phone.
